

**APPENDIX 3**  
**CRIMINAL OFFENSES THAT DISQUALIFY APPLICANTS FROM WORKING WITH CHILDREN**  
**AND VULNERABLE ADULTS IN THE**  
**CATHOLIC DIOCESE OF YOUNGSTOWN**

The Ohio Revised Code imposes particular requirements upon religious and charitable organizations which use volunteers who have unsupervised access to children on a regular basis. Specifically, a requirement for parental notification exists in the event a volunteer has been convicted of one of the offenses list in Ohio Revised Cod section 109.572(A)(1)(a).
