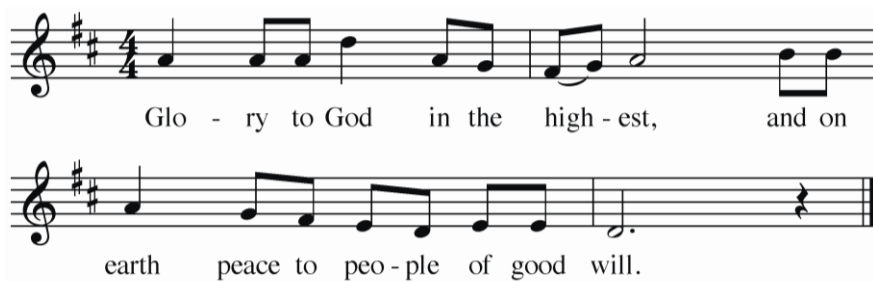

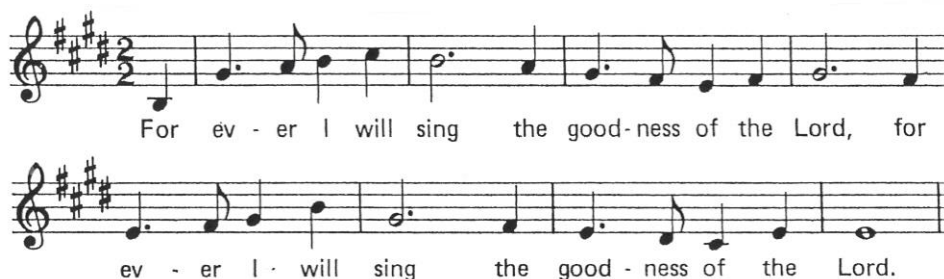

# LITURGY OF ORDINATION

## **Election of the Candidate** *(please be seated)*

*A Deacon calls the candidate by name and the candidate announces his readiness to be ordained.*

*The Bishop inquires as to the worthiness of the candidate. Reverend Scott Kopp, Director of Vocations, testifies that the candidate is worthy.*

*The Bishop declares the candidate chosen for priesthood and the entire assembly shows approval by responding: **Thanks be to God.***

## **Homily**

## **Promise of the Elect**

*The candidate stands before the Bishop who questions his intention to exercise the ministry of the word worthily and wisely; to celebrate the sacraments faithfully; and to pastorally care for those entrusted to him. The candidate then kneels before the Bishop promising him respect and obedience.*

## Litany of Supplication *(please kneel)*

*Just before the order of priesthood is conferred, the Litany of the Saints is prayed on behalf of the candidate. The candidate lies prostrate on the floor in a gesture of humility, signifying his total dependence upon God.*

## Laying on of Hands *(please stand)*

*In awesome silence, the Spirit of God is invoked upon the candidate as the Bishop lays his hands on his head. By this holy gesture, ancient in Scripture and Church tradition, the office of the priesthood is conferred. The priests present also lay hands upon the candidate to signify the oneness of priesthood which they all share.*

## Prayer of Ordination

*To complete the ordination, the Bishop offers a solemn prayer which praises and thanks God for the unfailing gifts of ministry to the Church. At its conclusion, all respond: **Amen.***

## Investiture *(please be seated)*

*The new priest is vested with a chasuble and stole.*

*The new priest is welcomed into the order of presbyter by the priests assembled.*

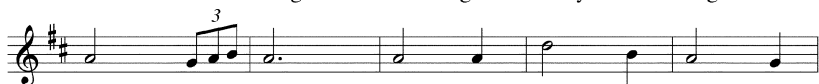

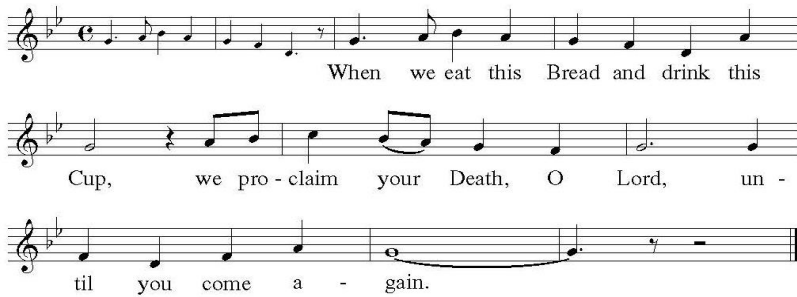

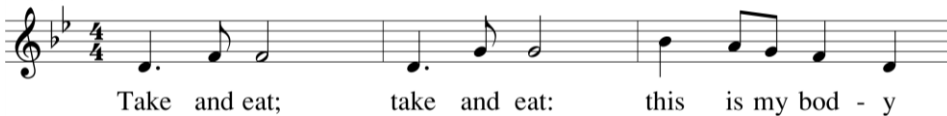
