## Bureau of Workers' Compensation

All Diocese of Youngstown employees are covered under Ohio workers' compensation law. The workers' compensation law provides wage loss and medical benefits to employees who cannot work, or who need medical care, because of a work-related injury or illness.

The Catholic Diocese of Youngstown is self-insured in matters pertaining to Ohio Worker's Compensation. The Diocese has been granted authority by the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation to pay claims directly.

In the event of an on-the-job injury or illness, employees shall promptly:

- ⇒ Notify your supervisor
- ⇒ Contact Rose Vocature, Employee Benefits Coordinator, at 330-744-8451, extension #263
- ⇒ Complete a First Report of Injury (FROI) form found on the Diocesan website: [doy.org](http://doy.org) >Resources >Finance
- ⇒ Seek evaluation and treatment from a medical care provider

*In the event of an extreme emergency, seek immediate medical attention and complete workers' compensation processes once condition is stabilized.*
