Some important points regarding participation in the Wedding Anniversary Celebration:

- The Wedding Anniversary Celebration includes Mass with the Most Reverend David J. Bonnar, Bishop of Youngstown, renewal of your marriage vows, a personalized certificate and a reception for you and your family.
- One or both of the spouses must be Catholic with the marriage recognized by the Catholic Church. **(Pastor's signature required on the registration form.)**
- The celebration is for couples. If it is not possible for both spouses to be present, the certificate can be forwarded directly to the couple.
- If you use a wheelchair, walker, cane, etc. and need special seating arrangements, please indicate your special needs on the registration form so appropriate seating may be reserved for you.
- Families are welcome to attend -- however, seating is reserved only for the couples celebrating anniversaries. Family members may use whatever seating is available behind the reserved sections.
- To insure your names will be included in the Anniversary Mass booklet, please be sure that your parish office has received your completed registration form **before September 30th**.
